

The chance of a child being immunized tends to rise with his/her mother's education level

<i>Mother's highest education level</i>	<i>MMR</i>	<i>DTP</i>	<i>DTP+</i>
Less than high school	91%	94%	77%
High school	92%	97%	83%
Some college	93%	99%	84%
College degree	92%	99%	89%

MMR=measles, mumps, rubella

DTP=3 or more of any diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis vaccines

DTP+=4 or more doses of DTP, 3 or more doses of polio, 1 or more doses of any MCV, and 3 or more doses of Hib
